### MAKE A DIFFERENCE

The Mackay Community Foundation accepts many forms of donations.

#### NAMED FUND

### AUSTRALIAN STREET AID PROJECT (ASAP)

Supporting: People who are without housing

#### Grant: \$10,000

**Purpose:** Established "Specialist Homelessness Medical Funding Pool" that assists by:

- Providing access to medical care from Mackay GPs, dentists and other essential medical services
- Transporting clients to and from medical appointments (eg client unable to walk long distances)
- Guidance and assessment from ASAP Registered Nurse who can ensure better rates of continued care by assisting with dressing wounds, GP liaison, patient education and medications
- Assisting clients to fill scripts that are deemed essential to their mental and/or physical health by GP



### SELECTABILITY

Supporting: Mental health and wellbeing

#### Grant: \$15,000

**Purpose:** Assisted in funding infrastructure for the "On Your Bike for Mental Health Program", which brings people together to exercise and promote mental health.



### TRUDY CROWLEY FOUNDATION (TCF)

Supporting: People impacted by cancer

#### Grant: \$24,500

**Purpose:** Purchased vehicle for TCF palliative care nurse to transport patients from their homes to various hospitals and other locations throughout the region, thereby not relying on the nurse's own personal vehicle for patient care.



### ALL ABILITIES MACKAY

Supporting: People who are differently abled

#### Grant: \$28,000

**Purpose:** Funded air conditioning for Summer House – a learning and friendship hub for children and families living with a disability, allowing for expanded activities during any type of weather.
